(1) A one-time Matriculation Fee of \$418 is assessed to all new and transfer degree seeking undergraduate and of \$364 to all new and transfer degree seeking graduate students.

(3) Applies to all degree programs and certificates except the Ph.D., which is charged at base graduate rates.

(4) All degrees in the College of Engineering except Medical Physics.

(5) Veterinary Medicine is a full-time program only. Veterinary Medicine students are not assessed the overtime fee. This exception to the general policy for other graduate programs results from the Veterinary Medicine curricular design which requires carrying larger SCH loads in certain terms for normal progress toward a degree. Fourth Year students taking a series of study, externship, and clinical rotations from the beginning of Finals Week in June to the end of Dead Week the following June are assessed the four term fees during that period of time. Fee payment dates will correspond to normal fall, winter, spring and summer term schedules.
